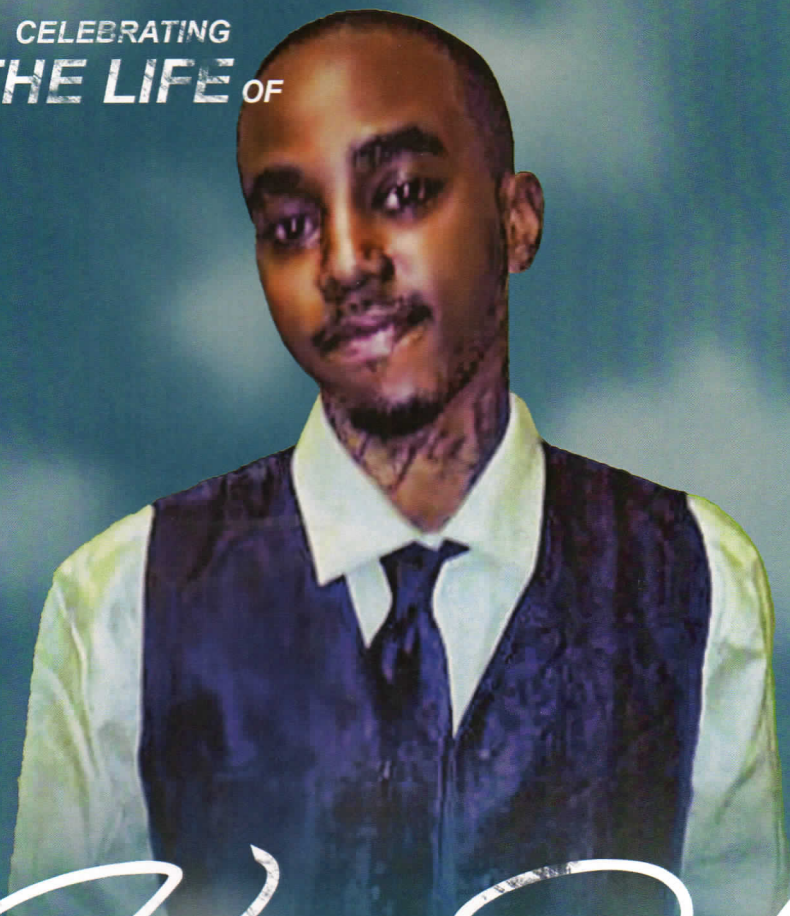

He leaves to cherish many memories:

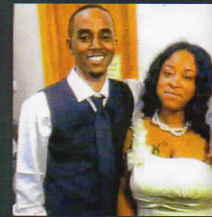
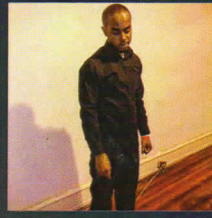
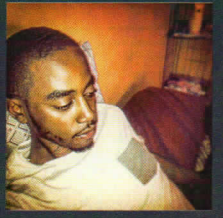
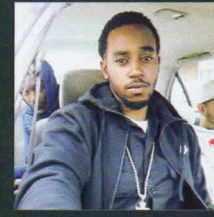
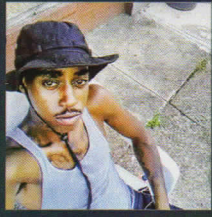
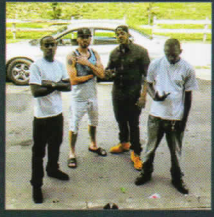
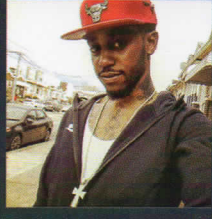
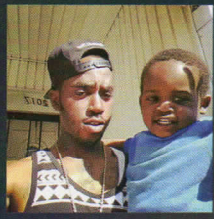
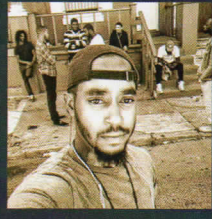
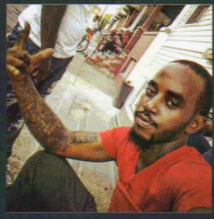
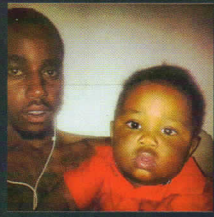
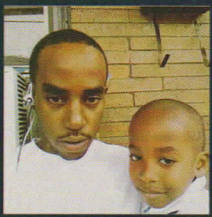
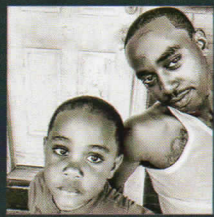
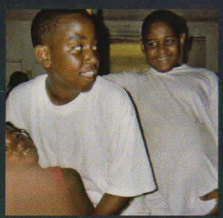

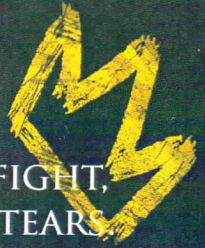
His Mother & Father: Virginia Johnson & Robert Lee Vicks
