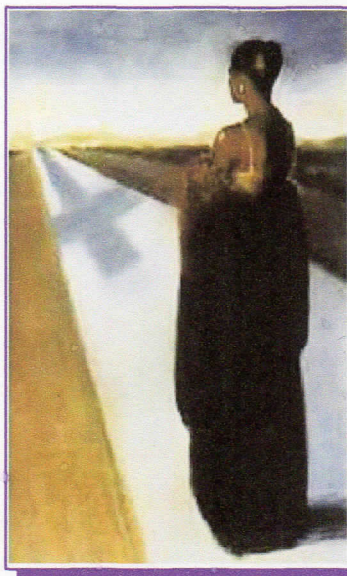
### *Miss Me, But Let Me Go*
