## *Life Reflection of Gladys Frame*

Gladys Reed Frame was born in Pineland, South Carolina on August 8, 1916. She was next to the youngest of ten children of Susie and Thomas Jefferson Reed. The close knit family relocated to the North and settled in Sharon Hill, PA where Gladys attended and was a graduate from Darby High School.

Gladys was married to George Frame in 1932, and when he died in 2003 they had completed seventy years of married life. They proved to be a good match. George planted and harvested his gardens; and Gladys cleaned and froze or canned the bounty. He built and repaired the house and she decorated it beautifully. From this union, they were blessed with two children: Marva Edna Wilkins and George Jefferson Frame.

Those who were fortunate enough to know Gladys were impressed by her charming smile and friendly demeanor. If lucky enough, they would experience her graciousness in her home where good food (her roles are legendary) and warm welcomes were abundant. Because she loves beautiful things, she surrounded herself with lovely fabrics, porcelains, cut glass, art and shared her joy with family and friends. In her spare time she crocheted, knit, oil painted, fired pottery and stitched fashions for the females in the family.

The Frames were active in their church, First Baptist Church of Morton where Gladys taught Sunday school and served as the Superintendent for years. She was a regular at Wednesday night Bible Study class and active in attending and arranging fund-raisers. Because she loved to travel she sponsored and arrangement many trips for her church family and friends.

Gladys' quiet, patient manner endeared her to most everyone she met and especially the children. They loved "Gigi". Her love was returned ten-fold during her illness because there was always someone nearby to attend to her needs.

Besides her children and her sister, Virginia Hamilton, Gladys is survived by three grandchildren: Michael Wilkins, Lisa Capers and Sheree Whiteside; nine great-grandchildren, and two great-great-grandchildren. They will deeply miss her presence in their lives, as will her foster children and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and friends whom she dearly loves.

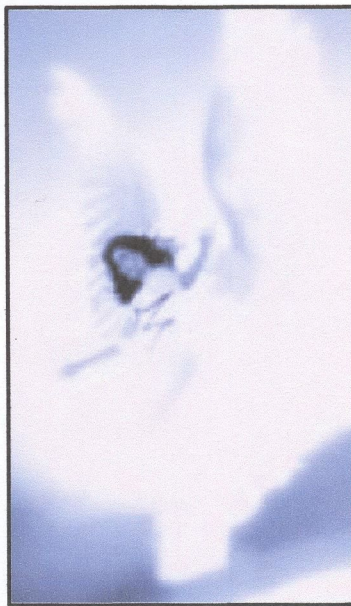
