

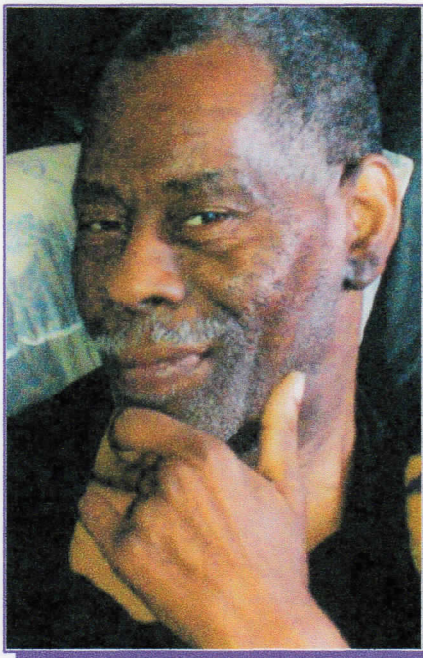

You were one in a million, and you'll always be

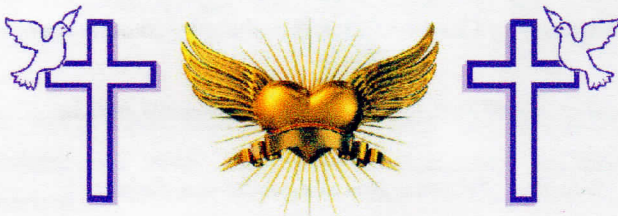
The precious and unique dad I care for so dearly...
