Obituary

Evelyn DOLORES McGlone was born on July 17, 1930 to the late William H. and Carrie Bilbry in Philadelphia, PA and transitioned from earth to Glory on October 10, 2014.

Dolores was affectionately known as Lorsey, Mom, Mom-Mom, Lo, Aunt Lorsey, Mother Lorsey and Mamacita. However, her life demonstrated a disciple for Christ, a true virtuous woman, and a lover of Jesus Christ. She accepted Christ at an early age, joined Miller Memorial Baptist Church at age 14 and was baptized by Rev. J. Luke Jones. She served God faithfully on the Fellowship Choir for many years. On any given Sunday, you might hear her singing "God Specializes." Around 1980 she wrote the song "Spiritual Growth."

Dolores was educated in the Philadelphia Public School System. After completing high school, she worked at Crown Cork and Seal for a while. She also cared for the children of her family and friends. On November 3, 1950 she was united in Holy Matrimony with her loving husband Riley McGlone, who preceded her in death. She would tell anyone who would listen how she prayed and asked God for her husband and He sent her Riley. The Lord blessed them with six beautiful daughters. One named Marilyn preceded her in death. After beginning her family, Dolores became the CEO of R & D Enterprise. She was the creative seamstress who designed unique outfits for her girls. She was a domestic engineer who made sure Riley and Dolores' children had the main ingredient for successful lives. She taught them about JESUS.

Dolores was a great teacher and utilized every opportunity to teach someone about the love of God, the faithfulness of God, and the love of family. She taught her siblings and children how to sing, how to get and hold the right note and how to belt out a song. She sang with the Bilbry Singers, The McGlone Singers and directed the Bilbryette Gospel Singers. Dolores was ready and willing to do anything for God and family.

Her life exemplified her love for God, family and friends. She was the epitome of love. Once someone came in contact with Dolores, they couldn't help but feel like part of her family. She had a way of making everyone feel special. The common thread of Dolores' 84 years was God first, love for Jesus, family and friends.
